

# A guide for planning your trip to Brno

This file contains additional information about CEITEC BUT location, public transport in Brno, transport connection to and from Brno and list of interesting options for accommodation.

## Transport to and from Brno

Brno airport Tuřany is situated south-east from the city center. It is small convenient airport with regular connections to Munich, London (Stansted and Luton) and Eindhoven ([www.bрно-airport.cz](http://www.bрно-airport.cz)). Flights are operated by Ryanair, Wizzair, bmi and Lufthansa. Some of the flights are not operated daily, please see [www.ryanair.com](http://www.ryanair.com), [wizzair.com](http://wizzair.com), [www.flybmi.com](http://www.flybmi.com), [www.lufthansa.com](http://www.lufthansa.com).

From the airport to the city center (main train station) you can get by bus number E76 ([www.bрно-airport.cz/en/parking-and-transport/public-transport](http://www.bрно-airport.cz/en/parking-and-transport/public-transport)).

Brno is well connected with Prague (2.5 h.) and Wien (1.5 h.) by direct trains. This lets you plan your flight to their airports and it offers an interesting option to spend some extra free days in some of these capitals. There is as well a direct bus connection from Wien Schwechat airport to Brno operated by Regiojet ([www.regiojet.cz](http://www.regiojet.cz)).

It usually takes about 2 hours to travel to Brno from Prague or Wien by car. You can park your car free of charge in front of the administration building in CEITEC BUT.



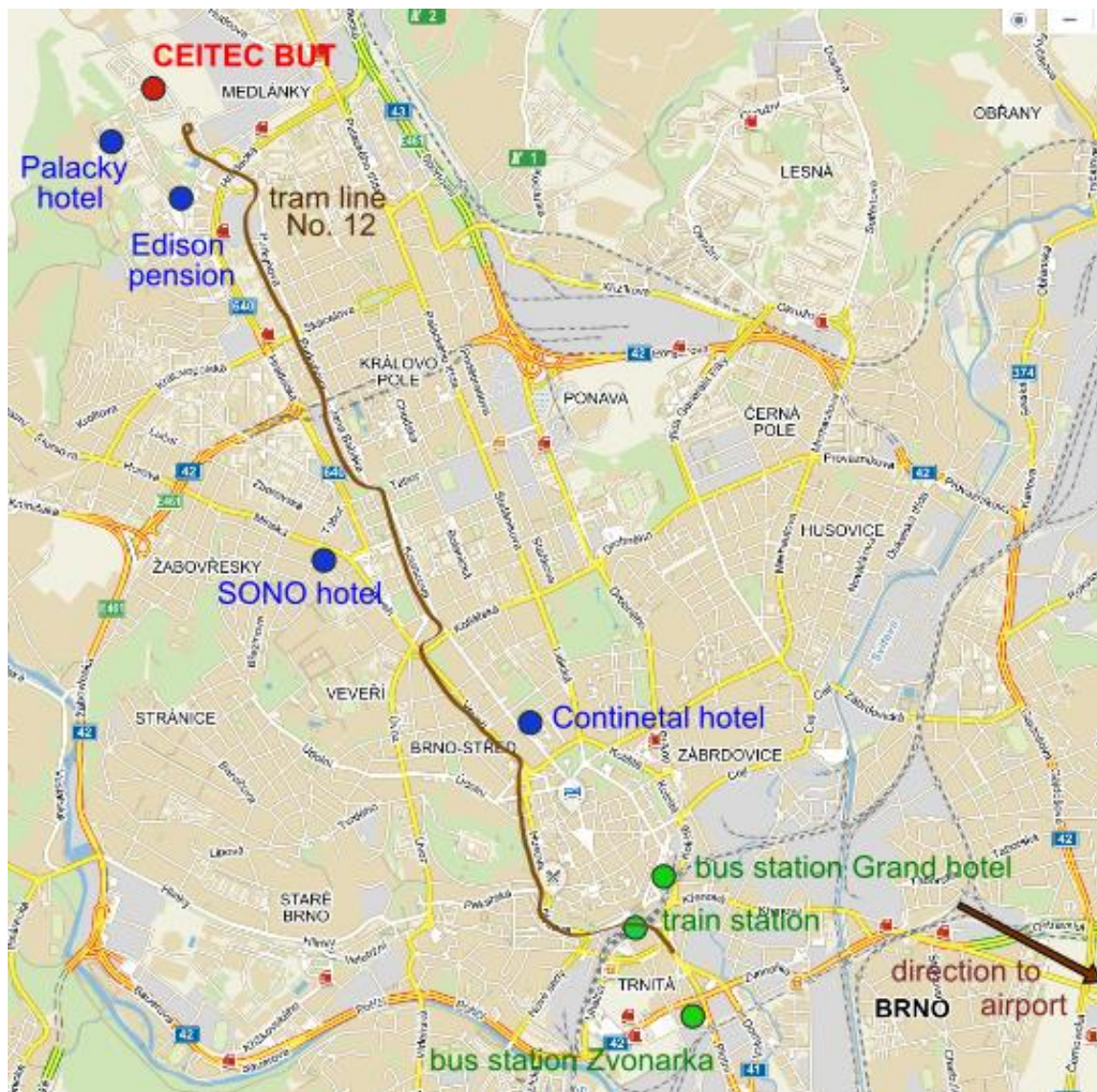
## Public transport in Brno

It is based on trams, buses and trolley buses. The basic ticket costs 25 CZK and lets you travel freely 60 minutes within the network. 20 CZK ticket is limited to 15 minutes and is sometimes too short to get from the city center to CEITEC. The ticket must be signed immediately after boarding a vehicle. For detail info about the public transport see [www.dpmb.cz](http://www.dpmb.cz).

Tram No. 12 stops in front of the main train station, goes around the historic city center and ends very close to CEITEC BUT (a tram stop TECHNOLOGICKÝ PARK).

The CEITEC institution has two main parts. The meeting will be held in CEITEC BUT situated at street Purkyňova. The other campus which is wrong destination for you is situated in Bohunice and is dedicated to life sciences.

## Accommodation

CEITEC BUT is located at the north end of Brno about 4 kilometers from the city center. The following list contains recommended accommodations:

- Hotel Continental Brno [www.continentalbrno.cz](http://www.continentalbrno.cz) is close to the city center with a good connection to CEITEC BUT by public transport. Brno University of Technology (BUT) has an agreement with the hotel. Participants of the workshop will be accommodated for special price 1350 CZK (about 50 EUR) per night (single bed room). To book your accommodation, please send an email to Jana Viktorinova ([viktorova@continentalbrno.cz](mailto:viktorova@continentalbrno.cz)) and mention “**LEIS workshop 2017**”. Your booking and the price will be confirmed.
- Pension Edison [www.pension-edison.cz](http://www.pension-edison.cz) is a small hotel and vegetarian restaurant, within the walking distance to the CEITEC BUT ap. 400 m.
- SONO centrum [www.sonocentrum.cz](http://www.sonocentrum.cz) has a new music club and hotel not far from the city center.
- Hotel Palacky [www.hotel-palacky.cz](http://www.hotel-palacky.cz) is a part of the student dormitory adapted to the hotel with reasonable price. Student canteens are open to public. Within a walking distance to CEITEC BUT (200 m).
